

- + Do students believe AI will change their future career/education?

Students will primarily use AI to save time on repetitive tasks and to gather information they might have otherwise missed during their college search.

Other Use Themes

- Many students still lack trust in Al
- Hyper-personalization is a key factor of use
- Students feel tremendous pressure; these tools help some feel like they are doing what they need to be doing






I don't think I'm that confident in which was Al or not. I think that's the point, though. It all sounds so human now. You can only look for that one weird word or some strange sentence structure to find it." Students decided which passages were written by AI by looking at the wording, such as flat and repetitive language, lack of understanding of emotion or true purpose, or the use of fancy or unfamiliar words.

Other Content Themes

- More use of Al did lead to higher identification scores
- Students identified training on human intelligence as the reason the task was difficult
- Perhaps surprisingly, 54% students scored the Al passages as better, with 17% saying there was no preference and only 30% for the human passages

Outlook on AI and the Future

Acceptable to Students

- Using AI to help with comms that are reviewed by humans
- Using AI to individualize content where possible
- Using AI chatbots if identified clearly and with alternative options for a human
- Using AI to plan, strategize, or learn about students
- Using AI to help with the job internally

Not Acceptable

- Using AI in anything related to an admissions decision
- Using AI to communicate critical information like financial aid or acceptance
- Using AI without attribution and clear identification
- Using AI to "spy" on students before or during college
- Using AI to replace humans in the workplace broadly

66 Now when looking at potential careers you have to look at how likely it is that you will have a career in the future seeing as AI is taking over a lot of manual jobs. In college there is more access to resources to study and learn from so it would be helpful to use it."

Al will have a significant impact on the college and career decisions that students will make. It will change the way students search for colleges, make decisions about majors, and consider future career prospects.

Other Impact Themes

- Some students think Al is just a "cool" fad that might go away
- Many students worry about deepfakes and information literacy with Al
- Job security was the number one concern for students thinking about their future
- Students want colleges to help them learn AI and support them with classes
